Personal telephone integration

Discovery 3 is available with an integrated telephone system which interfaces with the customer's own mobile phone.

The new hands-free telephone system uses the customer's own telephone mounted on a dealer-fitted cradle adaptor (available for selected business mobiles), which connects it to the vehicle wiring system. This cradle charges the mobile battery and connects it to an external antennae (mounted in the roof-top pod), whilst enabling full hands-free use of the telephone.

The telephone is integrated into the vehicle's audio system and has a microphone mounted in the roof console. Incoming speech is relayed through the normal audio system, which mutes the normal programme when a call is received or placed.

The functions available to the driver differ greatly depending on what make of phone they use.

Bluetooth 1.1 is also a function of the integrated telephone feature on Discovery 3, enabling any compatible phone to have full hands-free functionality and control through steering wheel buttons, and voice control, but without battery charging or external antennae.

By fully integrating the telephone into the control systems of Discovery 3, customers will benefit from the best quality communication whilst maximising safety by being able to keep both hands on the steering wheel during calls.
