




1. Remove the battery cover.

 - Release the two retaining clips,



Drill two 8 mm (0.3 inches) holes in the turbocharger as shown.





Installation

1. Install the turbocharger.





- 2. Align the turbocharger.
 - Tighten the turbocharger retaining nuts to 24 Nm (18 lb.ft).
- 3. Connect the turbocharger electrical connector.
- 4. Connect the turbocharger outlet pipe.
 - Tighten the clip.
- 5. Connect the turbocharger intake tube.
 - Reposition the turbocharger intake pipe to turbocharger connecting hose.
 - Tighten the 2 clips.
- 6. Install the turbocharger securing bracket.
 - Tighten the retaining bolts to 32 Nm (24 lb.ft).
- 7. NOTE:

Do not fully close the retaining clip at this stage.
