


## Removal

- 1. Disconnect the battery ground cable. For additional information, refer to <u>Specifications</u> (Section 414-00)
- 2. Remove the generator. For additional information, refer to <u>Generator (86.10.02)</u> (Section 414-02)
- 3. Remove the accessory drive belt tensioner.

Remove the retaining bolt.




- 4. Remove the crankshaft front oil seal. For additional information, refer to <u>Crankshaft Front Seal</u> (12.21.14) (Section 303-01)
- 5. Remove the generator mounting bracket.
  - Remove the five retaining bolts.

Remove the timing belt idler pulley. Remove the retaining bolt.





8. Release the battery positive cable.


Remove the two retaining bolts.





  - Remove the ten retaining bolts.
  - Remove the timing belt cover sealing strips.
  - Remove and discard the gasket.




## Installation

<sup>1.</sup> CAUTION: Make sure the gasket is installed correctly.

CAUTION: Tighten the 10 bolts securing the oil pump to the cylinder block before tighening the 4 lower oil pump retaining bolts.

Install the oil pump.

- Clean the component mating faces.
- Install a new gasket.
- Locate the oil pump onto the lower cylinder block.
- Align the oil pump with the cylinder block dowels.
- Install two oil pump retaining bolts in the positions shown, but do not tighten at this stage.
  - Install the 8 remaining bolts and tighten all bolts evenly to 10 Nm (7 lb.ft).



- 2. Install the oil pump lower retaining bolts.
  - Tighten the 4 bolts to 10 Nm (7 lb.ft).
- 3. Install the battery positive cable.

Tighten the two retaining bolts to 10 Nm (7 lb.ft).

- 4. Install the timing belt idler pulley.
  - Tighten the bolt to 45 Nm (33 lb.ft).

Tighten the bolts to 22 Nm (16 lb.ft).
