HOW TO SWAP THE FRONT PANEL OF HEVAC UNIT

Why?

I want upgrade my Disco with heated windscreen and, in 2nd step, heated seats.

I bought by eBay a used Hevac control unit from a HSE <2007 with grey front panel but my SE MY2008 have a Hevac with front panel in black.

It's possible then swap the front panels of the units? Yes, it takes only a screwdriver and 30 minutes of patience!


How to:

1. Remove the "H" panel of dashboard (many guides in disco3...) and remove 4 torx screw on side of Hevac unit



2. Pull three electric connectors and remove the unit





How to swap a front panel on a Hevac unit - v1.0

3. Remove the three wheels to adjust temperature and fan pulling up:




4. Remove 4 screw on back of unit:



5. With a screwdriver or plastic tool like one in the picture, leverage to open the unit:



6. Remove 3 screw on back of front panel:



7. Remove the front panel and the buttons frame:



- 8. Open the second unit (repeat process)
- 9. Swap the buttons frame (very easy, sorry no pics)
- 10. Reassemble the unit swapping the front panel
- 11. Mount your new Hevac in the car

The HEVAC now works but to operate the heated windshield you need to activate it via software!
