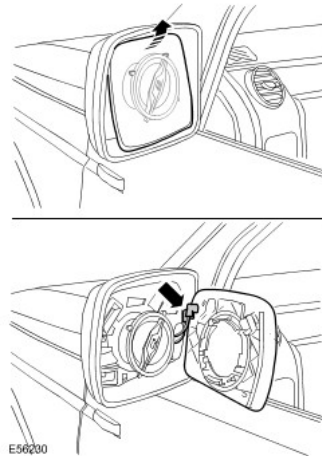
Exterior Mirror Glass (76.11.08)

Removal

1. Tilt the exterior mirror glass upwards.
2. Release the exterior mirror glass.
 - ▶ Carefully apply an even pressure to the base of the glass at two points, to release the 3



3. Remove the exterior mirror glass.
 - ▶ Release the glass from the motor.
 - ▶ Disconnect the 2 electrical connectors.



Installation

1. Install the exterior mirror glass.
 - ▶ Connect the electrical connectors.
 - ▶ Align the glass to the motor.
 - ▶ Apply an even pressure to secure glass to the clips.
2. Check the operation of the exterior mirror.
